(2) **Duration of course unit:**

Y = 1 full academic year

1S = 1 semester

(3) **Description of the institutional grading system:**

In Romania, marks are given on a scale of 1 to 10, with 5 meaning that “performance meets the minimum criteria required in order to pass”, 10 meaning “outstanding performance”, and 1 to 4 meaning “failed”

(4) ECTS grading scale:

ECTS Grade	Romanian Grade	% of successful students normally achieving the grade	Definition
<b>A</b>	10	10	EXCELLENT - outstanding performance with only minor errors
<b>B</b>	9	25	VERY GOOD - above the average standard but with some errors
<b>C</b>	7-8	30	GOOD - generally sound work with a number of notable errors
<b>D</b>	6	25	SATISFACTORY - fair but with significant shortcomings
<b>E</b>	5	10	SUFFICIENT - performance meets the minimum criteria
<b>FX</b>	4	-	FAIL - some more work required before the credit can be awarded
<b>F</b>	1-3	-	FAIL - considerable further work is required

(5) **ECTS credits:**

1 full academic year = 60 credits

1 semester = 30 credits

1 term/trimester = 20 credits
