Field: Business Administration

1. Specialization: BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (3 years, full time)
 - lines of study: Romanian and English

2. Specialization: BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION IN HOSPITALITY SERVICES (3 years, full time)
 - line of study: Romanian

Selection criteria:

- a. *For high school graduates with a high school graduation exam diploma, or its equivalent, the admission average is calculated as a balanced average between the high school graduation arithmetic mean – 80% share, and the high school graduation exam arithmetic mean – 20% share.*

This admission criterion is also applied to students in public or private higher education institutions who wish to apply to a second specialization at the Faculty of Business, as well as to the BA graduates who have NOT studied the first specialization in budgeted places and who do not challenge the special seats for BA graduates.

- b. High school graduates who have obtained the following distinctions in **Economy or Mathematics:**

1. distinctions at international school Olympics in at least one of the last years of study,
2. first place or the golden medal at the international school Olympics in one of the four years of study,
3. 1st, 2nd, 3rd prize in national or international school competitions, recognized by the Romanian Ministry of National Education, in at least on of the last two years of study,

may be enrolled without an admission exam within the number of places allocated by the Ministry of Education.

Candidates who have obtained the above mentioned distinctions may benefit from this facility in a 3-year period of time since their high school graduation.

- c. For BA graduates, the admission average is calculated as follows:
- the arithmetic average between the BA exam average and the arithmetic mean during the BA years of study;
 - the arithmetic mean between the graduation paper mark and the arithmetic mean during the BA years of study – for all promotions before 1993.
- d. For college graduates who want to complete their studies, the admission average is calculated according to the arithmetic mean between the graduation exam average and the arithmetic mean during the years of study.
