The International Relations and European Studies field

1. Specialization **INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND EUROPEAN STUDIES** (3 years, full time)

- lines of study: Romanian, German, English

SELECTION CRITERIA:

A.	School graduation examination	20%
B.	The arithmetic mean of the high-school years The annual arithmetic mean of the following subjects: History, Philosophy, Economy (the candidate chooses the arithmetic mean of a single year for the subjects studied throughout several years) <i>or</i>	40%
C.	The arithmetic mean of an optional subject in the field of European Studies	40%

1 History of Europe, the European Idea, the Philosophy of the European Union, the History of European Economy, European Political Structures, Community diplomacy, Knowledge about the European Union, Human rights, the Bases of community law, Transition economy, Economic and regional geography, European construction, the History of international relations, Theories of the European integration, European literature and civilization etc.

NOTE 1:

For the specialization INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND EUROPEAN STUDIES, the GERMAN line of study, it is compulsory that the certificate of linguistic competence be in German.

For the specialization INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS AND EUROPEAN STUDIES, the ENGLISH line of study, it is compulsory that the certificate of linguistic competence be in English.

The field of Management

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. School graduation examination 20%
- B. The arithmetic mean of the high-school years 40%
- The annual arithmetic mean of the following subjects: Mathematics, Economy, History (**the candidate chooses the arithmetic mean of a single year for the subjects studied throughout several years**) *or* 40%
- C. the arithmetic mean of an optional subject in the field of European Studies 1

The field: Cultural studies

4. Specialization **AMERICAN STUDIES** (3 years, full time):

- line of study: English

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- A. School graduation examination 20%
- B. The arithmetic mean of the high-school years 40%
- The annual arithmetic mean of the following subjects: History Philosophy, Economy (**the candidate chooses the arithmetic mean of a single year for the subjects studied throughout several years**) *or* 40%
- C. the arithmetic mean of a subject in the field of American literature, culture and civilization *or* the arithmetic mean of an optional subject in the field of European Studies 1

NOTE 2: For the AMERICAN STUDIES specialization it is compulsory that the certificate of linguistic competence be in English.

5. Specialization **JEWISH STUDIES** (3 years, full time)

- line of study: Romanian

Selection criteria for specializations 1, 2, 3, 4, 5:

- § The arithmetic mean from the C criterion
- § The arithmetic mean from the B criterion

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR THE GRADUATE STUDENTS (regardless of the specialization for which they opt):

- the arithmetic mean of faculty graduation (the arithmetic mean between the study years arithmetic mean and the graduate exam arithmetic mean)
- for the graduate students before 1994 who did not hold graduation exam, the arithmetic mean is calculated between the arithmetic mean of the study years and the arithmetic mean of the graduation exam.
- The punctuation for the final arithmetic mean is the following:
 - the arithmetic mean up to 6,99 - 3 points;
 - the arithmetic mean between 7,00 and 8,49 - 5 points;
 - the arithmetic mean between 8,50 and 8,99 - 10 points;
 - the arithmetic mean between 9,00 and 9,49 - 20 points;
 - the arithmetic mean between 9,50 and 9,79 - 30 points;
 - the arithmetic mean between 9,80 and 9,99 - 40 points;
 - the arithmetic mean 10 - 50 points

- Candidates are compelled to hold a linguistic competence certificate in foreign languages (English, French, German, Italian, or Spanish).
- The punctuation given for the linguistic competence certificate is 30 points.
- The candidates who have scientific activity through papers issued in specialized journals or in volumes printed by consecrated print houses are given 10 points (abstracts of the respective papers or photo copies are added to the admission folder).
- The existence of certificates, practice certificates or stages in public and private institutions in the country and abroad (including participation in the summer schools, scholarships abroad etc.) are given 10 points.

Observation: The maximum punctuation is 100 points, obtained as follows:

- 1) the arithmetic mean 10 - 50 points

- 2) certificate of linguistic competence - 30 points
- 3) scientific activity - 10 points
- 4) certificates, practice certificates etc. - 10 points

The equalization of points with grades is made as follows: 100 points are equal to 10 grade, for the rest of the grades the equalization algorithm will be decided by the admission commission and posted alongside the list of the admitted candidates.

Selection criteria for the graduate students:

- 1) The arithmetic mean of the graduation exam
- 2) The arithmetic mean of the faculty years of study

NOTE: The enrollment at the Faculty of European Studies is **conditioned** by acquiring a **certificate of linguistic competence** in international languages (English, French, German, Italian, or Spanish).

The following certificates of linguistic competence are accepted:
