Selection criteria:

Fields: Language and Literature; Cultural Studies

- High school graduates: high school arithmetic mean
- BA graduates: BA graduation examination arithmetic mean

Field: Applied Modern Languages

- High school graduates: arithmetic mean between the arithmetic means obtained in high school in: **FIRST FOREIGN LANGUAGE + SECOND FOREIGN LANGUAGE + ROMANIAN LANGUAGE**
- BA graduates: BA graduation examination arithmetic mean

Note:

1. The high school arithmetic mean in a foreign language is taken into consideration for 3 or 4 years, depending on the case (given the option for alternative manuals for 3 or 4 years in high school), belonging to the professors, not to the students.
2. Selection criteria between the students: a. high school arithmetic mean for the first foreign language (English or French); b. high school arithmetic mean for the second foreign language; c. high school arithmetic mean for Romanian.
3. Languages studied within the AML specialization: English, French, German, Spanish, Russian, Italian.
4. Stipulations:
 - first foreign language in AML: English or French
 - second foreign language in AML: one of the following – English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian¹.
 - Candidates who've not studied in high school one of the two languages they have chosen, may present a certificate of linguistic competence issued by one of the competent language centres (British Cultural Centre, French Cultural Centre, German Cultural Centre, Italian Cultural Centre, Alpha Centre, Lingua Centre) or an international diploma to certify a level of minimum B1 (according to the Reference European Common Framework). Replacing one language for another is conditioned by the certificate of linguistic competence at a level of 15 points according to the Reference European Common Framework.

¹ Taking into consideration the variable level of solicitation in Italian, Russian and Spanish, we wish to draw the candidates' attention upon the fact that for the enrolment they will be asked to have a different option as well (in case the number of candidates who opt for the same third language is sufficient for the forming of a group).

Selection criteria between the students:

Fields: Language and Literature; Cultural Studies

A. High school graduates:

1. the high school graduation examination arithmetic mean;
2. the arithmetic mean for the last year of high school studies;
3. the arithmetic mean for the penult year of high school studies.

B. BA graduates:

1. the arithmetic mean for the BA years of study;
2. the high school graduation examination arithmetic mean.

Filed: Applied Modern Languages

A. High school graduates:

1. high school arithmetic mean in the first foreign language;
2. high school arithmetic mean in the second foreign language;
3. high school arithmetic mean in Romanian.

B. BA graduates:

1. the arithmetic mean for the BA years of study;
2. high school graduation examination arithmetic mean.

High school graduates with a high school graduation examination who hold distinctions in international school Olympics during at least one of the last two years of study (2009-2010, 2010-2011).

High school graduates with a high school leaving examination who've received 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in national school Olympics in at least one of the last two years of studies (2009-2010, 2010-2011) will receive 10 points *ex officio*.

The nominal list of those who've obtained distinctions in school Olympics is approved through an Order issued by the Ministry of Education.

The candidates in this category will present the original diploma and a legalized copy of it.

Other distinctions

In Ethnology-Hungarian line of study, 10 points will be given *ex officio* for the following international certificates:

Hungarian language: the first 6 students awarded

- the Implom competition in Gyula
- the Kazinczy competition in Győr
- the competition in language correctness in Satoraljaujhely

Hungarian language: the first 3 students awarded

- the alternative contest in Hungarian language (grades 9th-12th, Sovata)
- the Hermeszkedo contest in Hungarian language (grades 9th-12th, Gheorgheni)

The candidates will present for the enrollment the original and the legalized copy of the certificate.
